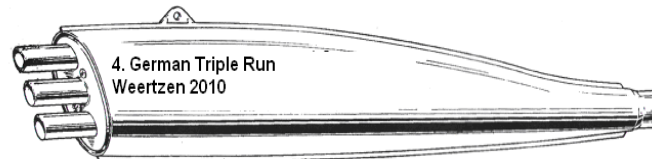

First stop is at the HafenMuseumHamburg where we will learn a bit about the hard work in the port in former days.

Next stop is at the "Alter Elbtunnel". Built in 1911 and 20 m below the Elbe it's real piece of art and because of the car lifts it's unique.

We'll leave the port via the "Kühlbrandbrücke", 50 m high above the water, to find our way home.
